

FT. BLOOMFIELD FAMILY RODEO SERIES

2017

GENERAL RULES

1. Membership fee \$50 for 2 family members living in the same household. (Single-family member household is \$25 membership fee.) \$5 for each additional family member within the same household.
2. WESTERN ATTIRE REQUIRED IN ARENA FOR ALL CONTESTANTS
3. MANAGEMENT DECISION IS FINAL.
4. No unnecessary roughness. No unsportsmanlike conduct allowed. NO ALCOHOL, IN OR NEAR ARENA. NO UNNECESSARY PROFANE LANGUAGE- PLEASE REMEMBER THIS IS A FAMILY EVENT.
5. No dogs allowed in Pavilion.
6. Compete in age division according to age as of January 1st.
7. Dummy Roping divisions, 5 and under, 6-8 years old, 9-11 years old.
8. Livestock chute run. Positions will be drawn.
9. One loop in all roping events.
10. Morning event Fees Paid by 8:30 a.m, ALL Other Fees Paid by noon, Team Roping Fees by 2:00 p.m. There will be a \$10.00 fee for all late entries. CASH ONLY – NO CHECKS. Once paid, fees will not be refundable.
11. Goat Tying- The goat must be tied by any three legs together for (6) seconds. If a contestant's horse runs over the goat or gets tangled in the goats rope, contestant will receive a 10 second penalty.
12. Barrels-Fastest time wins, five (5) second penalty for downed barrel-broken pattern is no time. No double riding or horse lead-ins, may lead in on foot only. Lead-ins will have a 99 second time. Contestant to compete only once. NO EXHIBITIONS.
13. Ribbon Roping- Thirty (30) second time limit. Enter once. First place buckles will be awarded in two divisions, mixed and open, one part of a mixed team must be 12 & under. NO reserve buckles in adult class. Ropers must be touching the calf, when runner removes the ribbon or will be disqualified. Runners must start from the designated area.
14. Poles-Five (5) second penalty for downed pole – broken pattern is no time. The 8 and under class will run 4 poles. Contestant to compete only once. No double riding or horse lead-ins, may lead in on foot only. Lead-ins will have a 99 second time. Contestant to compete only once. NO EXHIBITIONS.
15. Calf Roping – Catch as catch can. Calf must stay tied for (6) seconds. 15 & Under 60 sec. time limit and closed gate. Novice classification is lifetime earning <\$1000 or no finals qualifications or committee's discretion. 30 sec. time limit and open gate for Novice and Open.
17. Breakaway Calf Roping-Thirty (30) second time limit. Rope must pass over the calf head for legal catch. IRCA Rules – Open gate. Novice 60 sec. time limit, closed gate, <\$1000 or no finals qualification in any roping event or committee's discretion.
18. Team Roping – Mixed and Open Thirty (30) second time limit. Two loops. Three legal head catches: both horns, half a head or around the neck. Five (5) second penalty for one heel catch. . May enter twice. Change partner or ends. Roping will be flagged on the heeler. Mixed Team Roping- one contestant female or 14 & under. Youth Team Roping – Both ropers 15 & Under and a 60second time limit. Two loops. You may enter only two of the three team roping classes.
19. The producers of Ft. Bloomfield Family Rodeos reserve the right to refuse any entry.
20. Electronic Call-in is and two hour call in Monday before the Saturday Rodeo, if call in is missed, you must sign up Saturday and pay a \$10.00 late fee.
21. Yearend awards will be given to high money winners, with a minimum participation of two rodeos.
22. PLEASE PICK UP TRASH AROUND YOUR TRAILER OR AREA.
